STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND THIRTY-ONE

AN ACT Relating to the State School for Boys.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Appropriation for hospital bills. There is hereby appropriated the sum of fifteen hundred dollars for the fiscal year ending June thirty, nineteen hundred thirty-two, and one thousand dollars for the fiscal year ending June thirty, nineteen hundred thirty-three, to be paid to the State School for Boys to pay the expenses of patients committed to any hospital, infirmary, or other institution for surgical treatment or for disease.
