IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND THIRTY-ONE

AN ACT to Extend the Rights, Powers and Privileges of the
Sabattus Water and Sewer District.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Charter extended. The rights, powers and privileges of the Sabattus Water and Sewer District, which were granted by chapter forty-eight of the private and special laws of nineteen hundred and twenty-nine, are hereby revived and extended for and during a period of two years from the date when this act shall take effect; and all the rights, powers and privileges that were granted by said act to said Sabattus Water and Sewer District may and shall be exercised in the same manner and for the same purpose as provided in said act.
