STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND THIRTY-ONE

AN ACT Relating to Fees for Organization of Corporations.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Chapter fifty-six, section ten, of the revised statutes is hereby amended by striking out the last sentence thereof and inserting in lieu thereof the following:

'Sec. 10. Before said certificate is filed in the office of the secretary of state, such corporation shall pay to him for the use of the state ten dollars when the amount of the capital stock does not exceed fifty thousand dollars, twenty-five dollars when the amount of the capital stock exceeds fifty thousand dollars and does not exceed one hundred thousand dollars; ten dollars for each additional one hundred thousand dollars of the capital stock when the amount of the capital stock exceeds one hundred thousand dollars; also one-tenth of one cent per share and in no case less than ten dollars on all shares authorized without par value.'
