STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND THIRTY-ONE

AN ACT Relating to Catching Smelts in Salt Pond in the Towns of Bluehill, Sedgwick and Brooklin.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Smelts in Salt Pond protected. Section one of chapter two hundred eight of the private and special laws of the year eighteen hundred eighty, as amended by chapter ninety-six of the private and special laws of the year nineteen hundred twenty-seven, is hereby amended by striking out the whole of said section after the word "line" in the third line thereof, so that said section, as amended, shall read as follows:

'Sec. I. Smelts in Salt Pond protected. All persons are forbidden to take any smelts in the Salt pond in the towns of Bluehill, Sedgwick and Brooklin, Hancock county, in any other manner than by hook and line.'
