AN ACT Relating to Descriptive Roadside Signs Indicating
Names of Rivers, Lakes, etc.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Certain waters and historic spots to be designated by markers. The state highway commission is hereby authorized and directed to place suitable markers along the state highways designating historic spots, and the names of contiguous rivers, lakes and streams.

The necessary markers shall be made at the state prison under the direction of the warden thereof.
