## STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND THIRTY-ONE

RESOLVE, for the purchase of One Hundred Copies of the "History of the Town of Cushing."

Resolved: That the State purchase One Hundred copies of the "History of the Town of Cushing", by the late Judge Frank B. Miller, at a price not exceeding Eight dollars per copy, said books to be exchanged or distributed at the discretion of the State Librarian, and that there be and is appropriated for this purpose the sum of Eight Hundred dollars.
