STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND THIRTY-ONE

AN ACT to Prohibit the Catching of Smelts in the Cathance River Except by Hook and Line.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

P. L. 1925, c. 158, sec. I; relative to smelts in Cathance river. Section one of chapter one hundred fifty-eight of the public laws of nineteen hundred twenty-five is hereby amended by striking out, in the third line thereof, the words "above the iron bridge", so that said section, as amended, shall read as follows:

'Section I. Taking of smelts in tidal waters of Cathance river, regulated. No smelts shall be caught, taken or fished for in any way other than by hook and line, except in nets of two-inch mesh or more, in the tidal waters of Cathance river.'
