STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND THIRTY-ONE

AN ACT to Amend the Charter of the Eastport Municipal Court.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section one of chapter two hundred nineteen of the private and special laws of nineteen hundred three is hereby amended by inserting the word 'exclusive' after the word "the" in the last line of said section, so that said section as amended shall read as follows:

'A municipal court is hereby established in and for the city of Eastport in our county of Washington, which shall be denominated the Eastport Municipal Court, shall be a court of record, with a seal and shall consist of one judge who shall be an attorney at law and reside in said Eastport. He shall cause to be entered on the docket of said court all civil and criminal actions, with full minutes of the proceedings in and disposition of the same, which docket shall be at all times open to inspection, and he shall perform all other duties required of similar tribunals in this state; and copies of the records of said court, duly certified by said judge, shall be legal evidence in all courts. He shall not act as attorney or counsel in any action, matter or thing within the exclusive jurisdiction of said court.'
