STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND THIRTY-ONE

AN ACT to Increase the Salary of the Judge of the Municipal Court of the City of Biddeford.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section one of chapter two hundred forty-seven of the private and special laws of eighteen hundred eighty-seven is hereby amended by striking out all of said section and inserting in place the following:

'Sec. I. The salary of the judge of the municipal court of the city of Biddeford shall be sixteen hundred dollars per year, payable monthly on the first day of each month, which shall be in full for all his services and the services of his recorder. And in case of his death, resignation or removal from office, his recorder shall act and be paid the salary until his successor is appointed and qualified, and be subject to all the provisions of this act.'
