STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND THIRTY-ONE

AN ACT Relating to the Salary of the Commissioner of Agriculture.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section nineteen of chapter one hundred twenty-five of the revised statutes is hereby amended by striking out all of the first sentence of said section, and inserting in place thereof the following :

'The commissioner of agriculture shall receive an annual salary of three thousand five hundred dollars, provided, however, that the governor and council may increase said salary to an amount not in excess of four thousand five hundred dollars.'
