IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND THIRTY-ONE

RESOLVE, in Favor of Josiah W. Reed and Carleton Day Reed of Woolwich, Co-Partners in Trade and Doing Business Under the Firm Name and Style of Reed & Reed.

Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated to be paid to Josiah W. Reed and Carleton Day Reed of Woolwich, co-partners in trade under the firm name of Reed & Reed, the sum of one thousand five hundred sixty-seven dollars and fifty cents, to compensate them in full for all claims against the state of Maine, for contract executed by the trustees of the state sanatoriums, dated March one, nineteen hundred thirty.
