STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND THIRTY-ONE

RESOLVE, in Favor of Horace Kelly, of Island Falls.

Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated to be paid to Horace Kelly, commorant of Island Falls, the sum of fifty dollars to reimburse him for the damages caused to his potato crop by deers, during the summer of nineteen hundred and thirty.

To be paid from the current funds of Fish and Game Department.
