STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND THIRTY-ONE

AN ACT Relating to University of Maine.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Resident auditor. Section one hundred sixteen of chapter nineteen of the revised statutes is hereby amended by striking out in the first line of said section the word "shall" and inserting in place thereof the word 'may', so that said section as amended shall read as follows:

'Sec. 116. Resident auditor may be appointed by state auditor. The state auditor may appoint a resident auditor for the University of Maine, whose duties shall be to audit the accounts, and perform such other work as may be required of him by the state auditor, and under his direction, suitable office quarters to be furnished by the university. The salary and just expenses of the resident auditor to be paid from the state auditor's appropriations.'
