STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE • HUNDRED AND THIRTY-ONE

RESOLVE, In Favor of L. C. Hathaway.

Resolved: That the Forest Commissioner be and is hereby authorized and empowered, to execute and deliver a sufficient deed releasing to L. C. Hathaway of Passadumkeag, an actual settler thereon, all the right, title and interest which the State of Maine has in and to lots numbered seventy and seventy-one in the town of Passadumkeag in Penobscot County.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

Jan. 29, 1931.

To any Interested Party:---

This is to say that according to statements of old settlers and the oldest records we can find Lots 70 and 71 in the Town of Passadumkeag, have been in the Hathaway Family for nearly one hundred years.

Mr. L. C. Hathaway, the present owner has paid the tax on these lots for some twenty-six years, before that time his father paid the tax for thirty-five years more or less and back of this time the Grandfather Joshua Hathaway was in possession, he being a pioneer settler before there were any roads in that District.
