### STATE OF MAINE

#### IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND THIRTY-ONE

RESOLVE, Authorizing the Forest Commissioner to Convey a Certain Lot of Land to H. M. Lincoln.

Resolved: That the forest commissioner as land agent be, and hereby is, authorized to convey the interest of the state in Lot 23, T. 32 Mid. Div., Hancock county in consideration of the payment by H. M. Lincoln, of Corinna, to the state of Maine the sum of four hundred dollars (\$400) on or before August 1, 1931.

## STATEMENT OF FACTS

Mr. Lincoln received a tax bill on certain property and paid it under the erroneous impression that it was for his own property. As a result, his own property was sold for non-preparent of taxes.
