STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND THIRTY-ONE

RESOLVE, to Reimburse the Town of Chelsea for Assistance to Walter M. Coggsell, a Disabled Veteran of the World War.

Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated to be paid to the town of Chelsea, the sum of two hundred forty-seven dollars and sixty-nine cents, to reimburse said town for money expended for assistance to Walter M. Coggsell, a disabled veteran of the World War.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

Walter M. Coggs well and family had aid in the town of Chelsea to the amount of \$247.69 between May 1928 and August 1929. Since that time the family have received State Aid under the law providing for aid to the dependents of deceased and disabled veterans of the World War. The Selectmen of Chelsea cannot find that Mr. Coggs well and his family have a settlement in any town in the State and feel that their town should be reimbursed by the State for the amount expended, as above.
