STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND THIRTY-ONE

RESOLVE, to Reimburse the Town of Kingman for Assistance to Annie B. Baker, the Wife of a Disabled Veteran of the World War.

Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated to be paid to the town of Kingman, the sum of one hundred dollars, to reimburse said town for money expended for assistance to Annie B. Baker, the wife of a disabled veteran of the World War.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

Annie B. Baker is the wife of Clovis Baker. She was obliged to have help on account of serious illness. At the same time her husband was sick and was at the Marine Hospital at Portland for treatment. She received aid for a time through the World War Relief Commission, but it was necessary for the town to furnish additional aid. Her husband has since received substantial compensation from the Government, making further state aid unnecessary.
