IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND THIRTY-ONE

RESOLVE, in Favor of James M. Brown, of Clinton.

Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated, the sum of two hundred and ninety-nine dollars to reimburse James M. Brown, of Clinton, in full settlement against the state of Maine, for doctors bills and time lost, while working for the highway department, as a result of injuries sustained by him in his said employment. This money to be taken from the general funds of the highway department.
