STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND THIRTY-ONE

RESOLVE, in Favor of Building and Equipping a Feeding Station, or Rearing Pools for Fish, at or near Rumford, in the County of Oxford.

Feeding Station at or near Rumford, appropriation for. Resolved: That the sum of six thousand dollars be, and hereby is, appropriated, out of the general fund for the maintenance and work of the department of inland fisheries and game for the purpose of building and equipping a feeding station or rearing pools for fish at or near Rumford, in the county of Oxford, for the propagation and distribution of fish, said money hereby appropriated to be expended under the direction of the commissioner of inland fisheries and game.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

There is no state-owned feeding station in Oxford County, and because of the many lakes and ponds in that county, and the great number of fishermen who visit these lakes and ponds every year, it is necessary that a feeding station or rearing pools be established for the purpose of restocking these waters.
