STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND THIRTY-ONE

RESOLVE, in Favor of the Central Maine Sanatorium for the
Construction and Equipment of a School House.

Resolved: That there be, and hereby is appropriated for the
Central Maine Sanatorium the sum of eight thousand dollars
for the construction and equipment of a school house.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

At the present time it is not possible to take care of the children at the Central Maine Sanatorium who need schooling attention and this resolve is made for the purpose of providing such a school building.
