STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND THIRTY-ONE

RESOLVE, In Favor of the Central Maine Sanatorium for the Construction and Equipment of an Additional Building for Patients.

Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated for the Central Maine Sanatorium the sum of seventy-five thousand dollars for the construction and equipment of an additional building for patients.
