IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND THIRTY-ONE

RESOLVE, in Favor of the Northern Maine Sanatorium for the Construction of a Vegetable Cellar.

Resolved: That there be, and hereby is appropriated for the Northern Maine Sanatorium the sum of two thousand dollars for the construction of a vegetable cellar.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

The Northern Maine Sanatorium at the present time is without available facilities for keeping vegetables during the winter season, and this appropriation is made for the purpose of providing a proper place for that purpose.
