STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND THIRTY-ONE

RESOLVE, in Favor of the Central Maine Sanatorium for the Enlargement of the Nurses' Home.

Resolved: That there be, and hereby is appropriated for the Central Maine Sanatorium the sum of fifteen thousand dollars for the enlargement and equipment of the Nurses' Home.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

There is now pending before the Legislature a resolve for the purpose of constructing a new building for patients at the Central Maine Sanatorium, and in order to take care of the necessary help to carry on the new building, if constructed, it will be necessary to enlarge the Nurses' Home for that purpose.
