AN ACT Relating to Clerk Hire in County Offices.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Salary increased. Section forty-six of chapter one hundred twenty-five of the revised statutes is hereby amended by striking out in the second line of the twelfth paragraph of said section, relating to Piscataquis county, the word "three" and inserting in place thereof the word 'four,' so that said paragraph as amended shall read as follows:

'Salary of clerk in office of register of probate, increased. Piscataquis county: for clerks in the office of the register of deeds, eight hundred eighty-four dollars; for clerks in the office of register of probate, four hundred dollars; for clerks in the office of clerk of courts, eight hundred eighty-four dollars.'
