STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND THIRTY-ONE

AN ACT Relating to Returns Made by Lobster Fishermen.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section I. Lobster fishermen to make annual returns. All lobster fishermen shall make a return within one week after the first of July of each year, to the director of sea and shore fisheries of the estimated total number of pounds of lobsters caught by them during the year preceding such July first, together with a statement of their receipts during such year from the sale of such lobsters, and a statement of their estimated expenditures incurred during such period in their business, on blanks to be furnished by the said director.

Sec. 2. Repealing clause. All acts, rules and regulations inconsistent with the preceding section are hereby repealed.
