STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND THIRTY-ONE

AN ACT to Increase the Salary of the County Attorney of Franklin County.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section thirty-eight of chapter one hundred twenty-five of the revised statutes is hereby amended by striking out in the seventh line thereof, the words "seven hundred fifty dollars" and inserting in place thereof the words 'eight hundred fifty dollars,' so that said line, as amended shall read as follows:

'Franklin, eight hundred fifty dollars.'
