STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND THIRTY-ONE

AN ACT Increasing the Salary of the Judge of the Rockland Municipal Court.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section thirteen of chapter one hundred one of the private and special laws of nineteen hundred nineteen, is hereby amended by striking out in the seventh line of said section, the words "twelve hundred", and inserting in place thereof the words 'fourteen hundred', so that said section so far as it relates to the salary of the Judge of the Rockland Municipal Court, as amended, shall read as follows:

'The Judge of said court shall receive from the county of Knox, in quarter yearly payments, at the close of each quarter, an annual salary of fourteen hundred dollars.'
