STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND THIRTY-ONE

RESOLVE, Appropriating Money to Pay the Claim of Leon A. Higgins Against the State of Maine.

Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated, the sum of one thousand dollars to be paid to Leon A. Higgins, of Carmel, as a full and final settlement of all claims against the state of Maine, for destruction of buildings and damage to personal property by fire caused by Maurice Wilcox, a state ward.
