## STATE OF MAINE

#### IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND THIRTY-ONE

RESOLVE, in favor of the National Conference of Commissioners on Uniform State Laws and of the Commissioners from Maine for the Promotion of Uniformity of Legislation in the United States.

Resolved: That the sum of five hundred dollars for the period from July first nineteen hundred and thirty-one, to July first, nineteen hundred and thirty-two, and the sum of five hundred dollars for the period from July first, nineteen hundred and thirty-two, to July first, nineteen hundred and thirtythree, be and hereby is, appropriated, of which two hundred dollars for the year beginning July first, nineteen hundred and thirty-one and two hundred dollars for the year beginning July first, nineteen hundred and thirty-two, shall be paid to the National Conference of Commissioners on Uniform State Laws, and so much of the balance for each year beginning July first, nineteen hundred and thirty-one, and July first, nineteen hundred and thirty-two, as may be necessary shall be paid to the commissioners from Maine for the promotion of uniformity of legislation in the United States, for their expenses in attending the National Conference of Commissioners on Uniform State Laws, for drafting and printing reports, postage, and for their other expenses in performing the duties of said office.
