STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND THIRTY-ONE

RESOLVE, in favor of Reed Plantation.

Resolved: That there be and hereby is appropriated, from the Bridge Loan Fund, the sum of one thousand seven hundred and fifty dollars (\$1,750.00), to be used as part of Reed Plantation's share of the cost of reconstruction of Wytopitlock Bridge, under the Bridge Act.

STATEMENT OF FACT

The plantation assessors are to apply for State and County aid in the reconstruction of Wytopitlock Bridge. This bridge is located on the Military Road, Route 166, and is in poor condition. The Plantation is not financially able to pay its portion of the cost.

The valuation of Reed Plantation has been steadily decreasing and the tax rate has been increasing. In 1930 the tax rate was 86 mills. In a very short time all of the Military Road will be improved with the exception of a short piece in Reed Plantation, and it is believed that all available money should be used on this road, which shortens the distance to Aroostook County points fifteen miles.
