STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND THIRTY-ONE

RESOLVE, in favor of the towns of Gardiner and Randolph.

Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated, to be paid to the towns of Gardiner and Randolph, to aid in the repair and maintenance of the drawbridge between the two towns, the sum of one thousand dollars to be used for the maintenance of said drawbridge and twenty-five hundred dollars to be used for replanking or otherwise maintaining the floor of the same, for the fiscal year nineteen hundred thirty-two and one thousand dollars to be used for maintenance for the fiscal year nineteen hundred thirty-three, the money for this purpose to be taken from the bridge maintenance fund.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

This bridge is much used by the general public and the traffic is large. It is the connecting link between the Kennebec, Lincoln and Knox counties.
