STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND THIRTY-ONE

RESOLVE, in favor of the Town of Jonesport.

Resolved: That there be and hereby is appropriated, from the Bridge Loan Fund, the sum of three thousand two hundred and fifty dollars (\$3,250.00), to be used as part of the Town of Jonesport's share of the cost of reconstruction of Cummings Bridge, under the Bridge Act.

STATEMENT OF FACT

The reconstruction of this bridge was approved by the Joint Board at a meeting held June 10, 1930. The estimated cost is \$9,200, of which the town's share is 35.7%.

In 1930 the High School building in Jonesport burned and the town built a new one at a cost of \$23,000. The town has borrowed to the debt limit in order to take care of this school construction.

The tax rate is 66 mills and the town debt is about \$35,000. The town has never had a special resolve in the past.
