STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND THIRTY-ONE

AN ACT Relating to the Dixfield-Peru Bridge.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Chapter 103 of private and special laws of 1921 repealed. Chapter one hundred three of the private and special laws of nineteen hundred twenty-one is hereby repealed. This repeal shall take effect ninety days after the adjournment of the eighty-fifth legislature provided the new Dixfield-Peru bridge has been completed at that time and opened to the public. Otherwise it shall not become effective until the aforesaid new bridge is completed and opened to the public.
