STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND THIRTY-ONE

AN ACT authorizing towns to license public dance halls.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section 136 of Chapter 5 of the Revised Statutes is hereby amended by adding after subdivision XIII the following to be designated as subdivision XIV.

"XIV. Municipal officers of towns are authorized to make reasonable regulations for the licensing and conducting of dance halls, and to provide suitable penalties for violations thereof."
