STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND THIRTY-ONE

AN ACT Relating to the Construction of State Aid Highways.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

The Highway Commission may, at its discretion, in any year set aside from the joint fund provided by chapter twenty-eight of the revised statutes for the construction of state aid highways in any town a sum not exceeding the rate of one thousand dollars per mile, provided said sum is used for the purpose of applying tar or other surface treatment to any part, or the whole, of the way so constructed or which has been so constructed within five years then last past, said tar to be applied not later than July first of the year following the setting aside of said sum.
