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STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE  
HUNDRED AND THIRTY-ONE

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RESOLVE, for the Purpose of Grading and Constructing a  
Sidewalk on State Street in Front of the State House  
Grounds.

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Resolved: That there be and hereby is appropriated a sum of money not to exceed fifteen hundred dollars for the purpose of grading and constructing a cement sidewalk along State street in front of the grounds of the State House, extending southerly from Capitol street to the driveway leading to the State Highway building, the same to be expended under the direction of the superintendent of public buildings, and he is hereby authorized to make arrangements with the city of Augusta, the expense to be borne two-thirds by the state and one-third by the city, but the state's part to be limited as aforesaid.
