STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND THIRTY-ONE

AN ACT Relative to the Municipal Court at Pittsfield.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section one of chapter thirty-four of the private and special laws of nineteen hundred and twenty-three is hereby amended by striking out the words "eight hundred" in the second line thereof, and the word "twenty-three" in the third line thereof, and inserting respectively in place thereof the words "one thousand" and "thirty-one", so that said section as amended shall read as follows:

'Section I. Salary of judge fixed; county of Somerset to supply record books, blanks, etc. The judge of the municipal court of Pittsfield shall receive a salary of one thousand dollars per year, from and after July first, nineteen hundred and thirty-one, which shall be paid him in quarterly payments from the county treasury of Somerset county, which shall be in full for his services as such judge. All dockets, record books, blanks and such stationery and supplies as are reasonably necessary for the proper administration of said court shall be provided by the county of Somerset, and all bills therefor shall be audited by the county commissioners of said county.'
