STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND THIRTY-ONE

AN ACT Relating to Catching of Smelts in Fresh Water Streams

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Restriction on smelt catching. Section twenty-nine of chapter thirty-eight of the revised statutes is hereby amended by inserting after the first paragraph of said section the following paragraph:

'Provided, however, it shall be unlawful to fish for, take, catch or kill any smelt at any time, by any means, within an area beginning at tide water and extending to a point one-half mile above the same, in any of the fresh water brooks, streams or rivers and branches thereof which flow directly into tide-water; except smelts may be taken in the day time with hook and line in the ordinary manner.'
