STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND THIRTY-ONE

RESOLVE, Appropriating money to remodel, rebuild and repair the fish ways in the St. Croix River in Calais, County of Washington.

Resolved: That the sum of one thousand dollars be and hereby is appropriated, to be taken from the appropriation for the maintenance of the department of inland fisheries and game, to be expended by the commissioner of inland fisheries and game, to remodel, rebuild and repair the fish way in the Union dam and the fish way in the so-called Cotton Mill dam in the St. Croix river in Calais, County of Washington, and the commissioner of Inland Fisheries and Game shall have both said fish ways remodeled, rebuilt or repaired as he shall deem necessary, during the summer of 1931.

This appropriation to be made with the proviso that the state will pay one thousand dollars toward the remodelling, repairing and rebuilding of fishways in the St. Croix River, at Calais, if the Dominion Government, or the Government of the Province of New Brunswick, will pay a like amount towards this work.
