STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND THIRTY-ONE

RESOLVE, in Favor of the Frontier Water Company.

Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated the sum of one thousand dollars to the Frontier Water Company, a Maine corporation located in Fort Fairfield, Aroostook county, to compensate it for expense and damage occasioned by the rebuilding of a state highway in Fort Fairfield. This money is to be paid from the general funds of the highway commission. This is a full and final settlement of all claims against the state of Maine.
