## STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND THIRTY-ONE

RESOLVE, in Favor of Procuring Testimonials for the Purpose of Marking the Unmarked Graves of the Soldiers of the Revolutionary War.

Resolved: That the sum of three hundred dollars be and hereby is appropriated for the fiscal year ending June thirtieth, nineteen hundred and thirty-two, for the purpose of procuring testimonials to be used in marking the unmarked graves of the soldiers of the Revolutionary War.

Resolved further: With the approval of the governor and council, said sum shall be paid into the treasury of the Sons of the American Revolution, with which they are hereby authorized to procure and distribute such number of markers as may, from time to time, be required for the purposes herein specified.
