STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND THIRTY-ONE

RESOLVE, for Screening Certain Lakes and Ponds in the State.

Resolved: That the sum of eight thousand, three hundred and twenty-eight dollars and twenty-seven cents be, and hereby is, appropriated, to be taken from the appropriation for the maintenance of the department of inland fisheries game, to be expended by the commissioner of inland fisheries and game, to aid in screening the following named lakes and Provided, however, that no appropriation hereafter specified for the erection of a screen at the outlet of a lake or pond shall be available until some responsible corporation, or incorporated fish and game club, or the town in which the outlet of the lake or pond to be screened is situated, or some other town in the county in which said waters are situated, shall have, in legal town meeting, and having an article in the warrant for said town meeting for that purpose, by vote of record, voted to assume all liability for the keeping of said screen at all times free from sticks, leaves and all debris, so that the same will not become clogged and prevent the free running of water through the same, and provided, further, that said appropriation shall not be available until the citizens of the county in which said lake or pond to be screened is situated, shall have paid into the state treasury the balance

necessary, as found by the commissioner of inland fisheries and game, to erect said screen; and provided, further, if the actual cost of any screen provided for in this resolve is less than the amount appropriated therefor, the state shall be liable for only one-half of the cost of such screen. Any appropriation hereinafter named, or part thereof, not expended during the year nineteen hundred and thirty-one, shall be available during the year nineteen hundred and thirty-two.

For screening the outlet of Roxbury Pond, in Roxbury and Byron, county of Oxford, two hundred dollars. \$200.00

For screening the Outlet of Drew's Lake, in Aroostook County, (This screen to be erected only on approval of Commissioner and Advisory Council after inspection of the location during the summer of 1931) one thousand five hundred dollars,

\$1,500.00

For screening the outlet of Round Pond, in Rangeley, two hundred dollars, \$200,00

For screening the outlet of Lower Wilson Pond, in Greenville, two thousand four hundred and fifty dollars, \$2,450.00

For reimbursing Worromontogus Fish and Game Assocation, of Augusta, for one half of expense of installing a screen at Togus Pond (screen already installed) two hundred and forty-nine dollars and seventeen cents, \$249.17

For screening the outlet of Clemons Pond, in Hiram, two hundred dollars, \$200.00

For screening the outlet of Anasagunticook Lake, in Canton, one hundred eighty dollars, \$180.00

For screening the outlet of Wytopitlock Lake in Glenwood and in township two, range four, in the county of Aroostook, three hundred dollars, \$300.00

For screening the outlet of Nash's Lake, in the county of Washington, one hundred dollars, \$100.00

For reimbursing North and East Pond Fish and Game Association, for one half of expense of installing a screen at the outlet of East Pond, in Smithfield (screen already installed) one hundred and sixty-two dollars and fifty cents.

For screening the outlet of Watchic Lake, in Standish, two hundred and fifty dollars, \$250.00

For reimbursing the Bauneg Beg Fish Screen Association

\$149.77

for one half of expense of installing a screen at Bauneg Beg Fond, in North Berwick (screen already installed) two hundred twenty-six dollars and eighty-three cents, For screening the outlet of Stetson Pond, in Stetson, three hundred dollars. \$300.00 For screening the outlet of Orneville Pond, in Orneville, Piscataquis County, one hundred sixty dollars, \$160.00 For screening the outlet of Clearwater Pond, in Franklin County, one thousand dollars, \$1,000.00 For screening the outlet of China Lake, in China and Vassalboro, seven hundred dollars, \$700.00 For reimbursing Knox County Fish and Game Association for one half of expense of installing a screen at the outlet of Lermond's Pond (screen already installed) one hundred
