RESOLVE, Appropriating Money for the Completion of the
Statue of General Howard.

Statue of General Howard Appropriation.

Resolved: That there be and hereby is appropriated the sum of thirty-five thousand dollars (\$35,000) to be expended by the Governor and Council at their discretion for the completion of the statue of Major General Oliver Otis Howard.

Commission increased. The governor by and with advice and consent of the council is hereby authorized and empowered to appoint two additional members to said commission and to fill any vacancy in said commission to serve without pay and to have the same powers and duties as the members heretofore appointed on the commission under the provisions of chapter one hundred twenty-one of the resolves of nineteen hundred twenty-nine.
