STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND THIRTY-ONE

RESOLVE, in Favor of the Trustees of Hebron Academy.

Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated the sum of one thousand six hundred fifty-nine dollars and eighty-three cents to be paid to the Trustees of Hebron Academy to reimburse it for expenses incurred and cash paid out to repair its water pipes on account of injuries to said pipes by reason of the building of a new highway on the street or road leading by Hebron Academy where said pipies are laid. This is a full and final settlement against the State of Maine. This money is to be paid from the General Funds of the Highway Commission.
