STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND THIRTY-ONE

RESOLVE, In favor of the towns of Mexico and Rumford.

Resolved: That there be and hereby is appropriated, from the Bridge Loan Fund, the sum of seven thousand five hundred dollars (\$7,500) to aid the town of Rumford, and seven thousand five hundred dollars (\$7,500) to aid the town of Mexico, in the construction of a sidewalk bridge adjacent to the Ridlonville Bridge, so-called, over the Androscoggin River, connecting the two towns.

This resolve is on condition that the towns of Mexico and Rumford raise sufficient funds to complete the said sidewalk bridge. The work to be done under the direction of the State Highway Commission.
