IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND THIRTY-ONE

RESOLVE, Making an Appropriation for the Improvement
of the State Aviation Field at Augusta.

Resolved: That there be and hereby is appropriated the sum of four thousand five hundred dollars for the purpose of removing the infantry unit building and equipment building, now situated on the Winthrop Street side of the aviation field in Augusta belonging to the State of Maine, to the land situated on the southwesterly corner of Blaine Avenue and Winthrop Street, subsequent to its conveyance to the State of Maine, and for the purpose of connecting said buildings, after their removal, with sewer and water systems, said sum to be expended by the adjutant general. Said funds to be provided from surplus revenue.
