STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND THIRTY-THREE

AN ACT Relating to Trapping of Wild Animals.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Wild animal traps may be baited with rabbits. It shall be lawful to bait traps lawfully set for the catching of wild animals with wild rabbits.
