HUNDRED AND THIRTY-THREE

RESOLVE, Relating to Fishing in Pleasant Lake, in
Island Falls.

Fishing in Pleasant Lake regulated. Resolved: That the
commissioner of inland fisheries and game is hereby directed
to issue a rule and regulation limiting the length of trout that
may be legally taken in Pleasant lake, in Island Falls, to not
less than 10 inches.
