IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND THIRTY-THREE

AN ACT Relating to the Printing of Public Laws in News-
papers.

Emergency Preamble: Whereas under the existing law a considerable sum of money is expended by the state for unnecessary distribution of public laws in newspaper form, the present method of distribution duplicating many times what might reasonably be regarded merely as a matter of convenience to the people of our state if such distribution were limited to a single copy for each voter of our state, and

Whereas in the judgment of the legislature these facts create an emergency within the meaning of section 16 of Article XXXI of the constitution of Maine and require the following legislation as immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety, therefore

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S. c. 2, sec. 67, repealed. Section 67 of chapter 2 of the revised statutes is hereby repealed.

Emergency clause. In view of the emergency cited in the preamble, this act shall take effect when approved.
