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AN ACT Requiring the Filing and Preservation of Annual Statements  
of Insurance Companies.

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Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows :

**R. S. c. 60, § 155, amended.** Section 155 of chapter 60 of the revised statutes is hereby amended to read as follows :

**'Sec. 155. Annual statement to be filed with commissioner.** Every such company shall, in the month of January, annually, also deposit with the said insurance commissioner a similar statement of its capital, assets, and liabilities, and the investments and risks as aforesaid, to be made up to the thirty-first day of December next preceding, signed and sworn to as above directed, and the insurance commissioner, in his annual report, shall publish a abstract thereof. **Such annual statements shall be retained in the files of the insurance department for the term of five years, after which period they may, with the approval of the commissioner, be destroyed.'**
